## Requirements for Confirmation:

1. We demand RESPECT! Each young person is expected to respect the speaker, their small group leaders, their peers and themselves. If a young person is not being respectful, they will be removed from the event and have their parents called to pick them up. If it is a required event, they will be required to make up the event.
2. Each person must complete two (2) years of LIFE Nights and one (1) year of ROC.
3. Each young person MUST attend a Retreat with our Program, in addition to their Confirmation Retreat, before they will be allowed to Confirm. Typically, they will have four (4) Retreats per year to choose from (Fall Retreat, Spring Retreat, Steubenville Conference or RISE Work Week)
4. Each young person is allowed to miss two (2) LIFE Nights per semester. If he/she missed additional LIFE Nights, he/or she will have their parents called and will be required to write a paper on the topic of the night.
5. Each young person is required to complete Community Service hours each year. Freshman need to complete 5 hours of Service, sophomores need to complete 10 hours of service and juniors need to complete 15 hours of service. The service opportunities on the schedule are a few things that they can do to complete their hours.
6. Each young person, each year, will be required to complete five (5) hours of spiritual enrichment. These hours are designed to help the young person grow to spiritual maturity and in relationship with God. These hours can be accomplished by coming to a worship night, attending a daily mass, completing a prayer journal, reading an approved book on spirituality, meditating on scripture, praying a rosary etc.
7. Each young person, because our church exists to bring Jesus to others, will be required to complete five (5) hours of evangelization per year. This can be done by bringing a friend, who is not registered in our Program, to an event.
8. In addition to attending LIFE Nights (9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade years) and ROC Luncheons (11<sup>th</sup> Grade year), each young person must complete a Scripture Study and a Morality Study.
9. In Addition to the above requirements, it is expected that each young person is attending Mass on, at minimum, Sundays and frequenting the Sacrament of Reconciliation when needed.

Our Ministry exists to **REFLECT** Christ to un-churched teenagers, to **PLUG** them into a community that will **ROOT** them in their faith, and challenge them to **SPREAD** their faith to others as they **GLORIFY** God with their lives.
